




MASTER PLAN

HOMEOWNERS DUES

Your homeowners dues should have been paid at the time of closing by the title company. The homeowner will be responsible for annual dues after the first year of moving in. (Payment is due annually at the beginning of January)

Dues are used to pay for maintenance of the common areas. That includes trees, ponds, entrances, landscaping along Mustang Road, playgrounds, and Splash Pad.

Dues Breakdown: \$450 per year
